Winter says, "Soup's on!"

TORTELLINI, WHITE BEAN & SPINACH SOUP

- 1 tsp. olive oil
- 2 C. chopped onion
- 1/2 C. chopped red pepper
- 1 tsp. dried Italian seasoning
- 3 garlic cloves, chopped
- 2 C. coarsely chopped spinach
- 2/3 C. water
- 1 16 oz. can jalapeno, navy or pinto beans, dried
- 1 14 oz. can vegetable broth
- 1 14.5 oz. can no-salt added tomatoes, undrained and chopped
- 1 14 oz. can artichoke hearts, drained
- 1 9 oz. pkg. uncooked fresh cheese filled tortellini
- 1/4 C. grated fresh parmesan cheese

Heat oil in a large dutch oven over medium high heat. Add onion, pepper, Italian seasoning and garlic. Saute' 5 minutes or until tender. Add spinach, water, beans, broth, tomatoes and artichokes. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat, simmer for 2 minutes. Add tortellini and cook until thoroughly heated. Sprinkle with cheese.

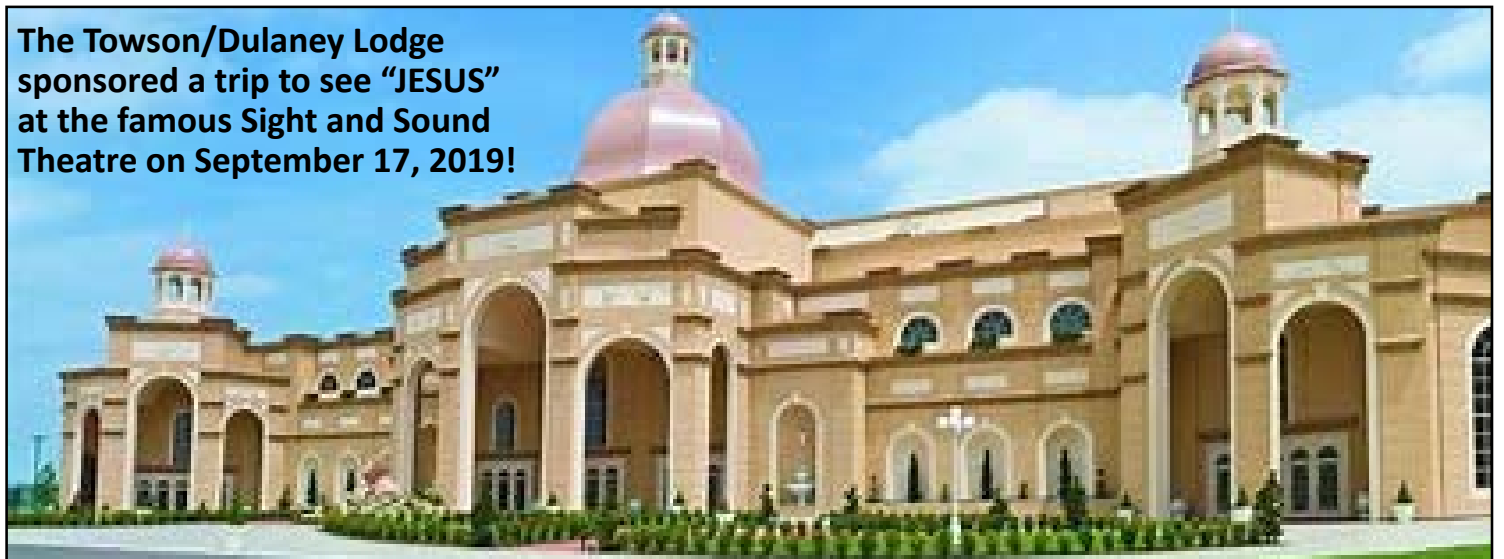

Constantino Brumidi Statue Dedication

Constantino Brumidi is considered to be the 'Michaelangelo' of America. He is most noted as the artist who painted the Dome (and some rooms) in the Capital Building in Washington, D.C., as well as rooms in the White House.

Mr. Brumidi was born in Rome in 1835. Brumidi emigrated to America around the age of 27, having a very interesting background. He is of both Italian and Greek descent.

A statue in his honor was dedicated in Annapolis, MD on October 19, 2019 - thanks to the Foundation of Hellenism in America and the Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in America. Annapolis, MD was chosen because Maryland has a large population of those of Italian and Greek descent – it is close to Washington, D.C., which also has a large population of those of Italian and Greek descent.

Mayor Gavin Buckley and the City Council of Annapolis agreed that the Brown-Leanos Park would fit the bill in allowing the statue to be placed there. They are right. A beautiful breakfast reception took place prior to the dedication - with many notable speakers - and a champagne toast and cutting of a cake - followed the dedication.

The bronze statue, sculpted in Verona, Italy, was bought and paid for by the members and friends of the Foundation of Hellenism. The beautiful base of the statue was funded by the Supreme OSDIA Foundation and the Grand Lodge of MD, as well as Dominic Petrucci Contractor, Inc. (who built the base) and friends. A plaque on the base lists all major contributors. OSI Foundation President, Joe Sciame, traveled from New York to share in the dedication.

It was a wonderful tribute to Mr. Brumidi, a very talented artist. If you are ever in Annapolis, stop by and see the statue. You will not be disappointed – and as an Italian/Italian American – should make you proud!
