# HAPPY BIRTHDAY, OSIA! THANK YOU, DR. VINCENZO SELLARO!

On June 7<sup>th</sup>, the OSIA (OSDIA) celebrated its 118<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY!  
The OSIA is the oldest and largest Italian-American organization in the United States!

Vincenzo Sellaro was the founder of the Order Sons of Italy in America. He was born in 1868 in Polizzi Generosa in the province of Palermo, Sicily. In 1895, he received his medical degree from the University of Naples. He immigrated to the United States in 1897 and settled in New York City. The following year, he completed his post-graduate courses at the Cornell Medical School and obtained a license to practice medicine in New York State.

He established his own private practice on Grand Street in the 'Little Italy' neighborhood in Manhattan. There he saw many Italian immigrants often placed in life threatening situations in hospitals because of the language barrier.

He later joined the AMA, conducted research on diabetes and cancer. He organized a school for midwives under the auspices of the New York City Health Board. This school eventually was merged with others into the famous School at Bellevue.

He married Maria Lignante, from Naples. They had 3 children and their only son would later describe him as a loving father who provided a warm family life.

Vincenzo Sellaro became a naturalized citizen in 1904 and sent one-way steamship tickets to his two brothers and two sisters in Italy. His widowed father also came, but soon returned to Italy.

Dr. Sellaro conceived the idea of bringing ALL Italian Americans together in a single brotherhood organization to help with jobs, housing, etc. His project took shape on June 7, 1905 during a meeting held at his home, attended by the lawyer Antonio Marzullo, pharmacist Ludovico Ferrari, sculptor Giuseppe Carlino and two barbers Pietro Viscardi and Roberto Merlo. Other meetings followed until the Order Sons of Italy in America (today OSDIA) was established and Dr. Sellaro became its National President!

Since 2019, we are very proud and happy to say that there are two established OSIA lodges present in Italy today. One is in Rome and the other is in Palermo, Sicily. The OSIA, with a group of 20 or more (along with students studying in Italy) flew to Rome, then to Palermo to celebrate their being a part of the Order Sons of Italy in America.



The OSIA is still helping people! The OSIA is very philanthropic and has donated over \$170 million to various charities in the past 25 years. Scholarships are given each year to no less than 8 to 10 students from across the country. A re-constructed van is given to a veteran each year at the Nela Dinner and there is much, much more to brag about!!

# CELEBRATING the FOURTH OF JULY is important!!!

## *(Farmer's Almanac)*

The Fourth of July started Democracy as a way of government and human dignity as a way of life! It's America's revolutionary Charter of Freedom and the document upon which the nation's founding principles were established.

The Declaration of Independence is one of the most important documents in the history of the United States. It was an official act taken by all 13 American colonies in declaring independence from British rule.

The document was originally written by Thomas Jefferson, but Benjamin Franklin and John Adams, along with Jefferson, then worked together to make changes to it.

### HERE IS THE WELL-KNOWN EXCERPT FROM THE DECLARATION (1776):

*"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness."*

### FOURTH OF JULY HISTORY:

*Thomas Jefferson noted in his 'Weather Memorandum Book' that the weather was cloudy, temperature, 76 degrees F on July 4th.*

*Both Thomas Jefferson and John Adams - both signers, died on the 50th Anniversary of the adoption of the Declaration.*

*Only 2 men signed the Declaration – John Hancock, President of Congress and Charles Thompson, Secretary Of Congress.*

*The Fourth of July was not declared a federal holiday until 1938.*

*Written on the back of the Declaration of Independence – "Original Declaration of Independence dated 4th July 1776" – written upside down. Many thought it was a Treasure Map as suggested in a movie!*





# THE GARIBALDI MEUCCI MUSEUM

*(Owned and operated by OSDIA)*

*I talk a lot about the Garibaldi Meucci Museum, but more than likely many of our members have never heard of it or know about it. So, believing that it is a proud source of information for Italian Americans (OSDIA members in particular), I thought it appropriate to supply a little information about the Museum.*

*The Garibaldi Meucci Museum (GMM) was the home of inventor Antonio Meucci and the legendary international hero, Guiseppe Garibaldi. The home was built in 1840 and was being rented at that time by Antonio and Ester Meucci.*

*In 1850, Garibaldi arrived in New York seeking refuge. Antonio offered him the hospitality of his home, and they worked together in Meucci's candle factory.*

*In 1854, Garibaldi returned to Italy, leading military forces that would provide for the unification of Italy and would win him worldwide fame! When Garibaldi died in 1882, a committee was formed to commemorate the hero's stay at the house. In 1884, Meucci was present when a plaque was placed over the front door of the house honoring Garibaldi. After Meucci's death, the house was then turned over to the Italian Community to be preserved as a memorial to General Giuseppe Garibaldi.*

*The home is a National Historic Landmark located in Staten Island, NY, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It is a 501 3c nonprofit organization that has been owned by the Sons of Italy Foundation (SIF) since 1919, and administered by the OSDIA Grand Lodge of New York. The OSDIA is the only Italian organization who has its own museum. It depends mostly on grants and donations. All donations are tax-deductible.*

*In 1907, on the centennial of Garibaldi's death, the house was moved to its present location.*

*In 1919, the Garibaldi Society turned the house over to the Order Sons of Italy in America. The Order has restored and maintained the house ever since. The artifacts in the Museum were donations collected from around the world with the help of the Cultural Department of the Italian Embassy.*

*The mission of the Museum is to collect, hold, own, maintain, preserve and exhibit historical objects and information relating to the lives of General Guiseppe Garibaldi and Antonio Meucci; promote an understanding of Italian American heritage and a positive image of Italian Americans; conduct educational, cultural and artistic programming designed to eliminate ethnic and racial prejudice for a diverse and growing present and future audience!*

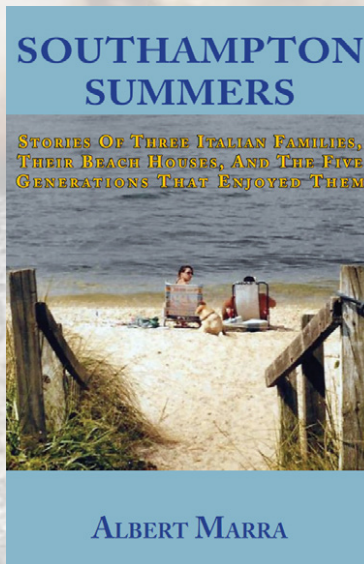

1. If you get a sunburn, restore your energy with salt tablets or hot tea, which will pep you up and cool you off as well as or better than a cold drink.
2. A simple and harmless remedy for sunburn is to bathe your face in buttermilk.
3. Grate potatoes and apply to sunburned skin. The starch will cool and soothe.
4. Use Apple Cider vinegar (plain or diluted) to ease the sunburn.
5. Apply ice or cold water.
6. Dissolve Epsom salts or baking soda in water; apply to clean cloth and drape cloth over affected skin.
7. Apply aloe vera or plain yogurt with live cultures, or coconut oil to the burn.
8. Add some black or green tea to your bathwater to soothe the skin or pat sunburned skin with wet tea bags.
9. Apply a compress of decocted witch hazel.
10. If your sunburn is itchy instead of painful, try oatmeal to ease the itch.
